In the 30-lesson modules, designed in accordance with the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) levels, all four language competences (listening and reading comprehension, speaking and writing skills) are simultaneously developed.

In addition to the acquisition of language skills, lessons on Hungarian Culture are also included in the course programme.

In the 30-lesson modules, designed in line with the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) levels, all four language competences (listening and reading comprehension, speaking and writing skills) are simultaneously developed.

In addition to the acquisition of language skills, lessons on Cultural Studies are also included in the course programme.
