

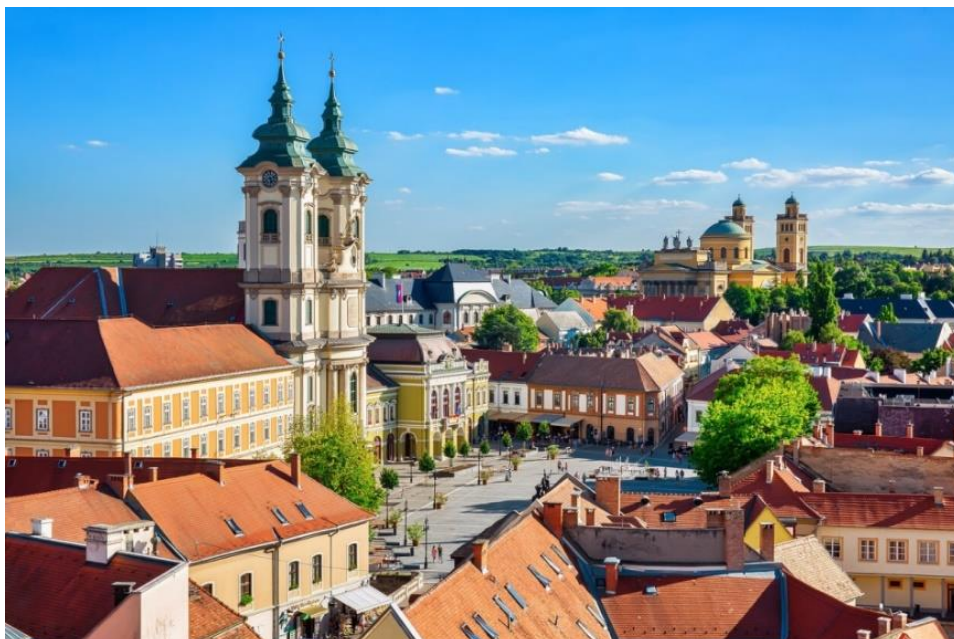

Eszterházy Károly Catholic University is a leading, dynamically developing institution of higher education in Hungary offering marketable courses, unique scholarship opportunities and a family atmosphere to students in five faculties in Eger and Jászberény. EKCUC offers courses in Agriculture, Humanities, Teacher training, Economics and Social Sciences, Natural Sciences, Information Technology, Sports Sciences and Arts but we place a strong emphasis on dual training as well. Our university welcomes applicants to a service- and student-centred institution where we provide excellent conditions for learning, housing and leisure activities with equal opportunities and support for disadvantaged students. # 1 INTENSIVE AND PREPARATORY LANGUAGE COURSES FOR INTERNATIONAL LEARNERS

Off-campus courses are taught in person or online, by our highly qualified staff with expertise in teaching international students.*

## 1.1 ONE-YEAR INTENSIVE HUNGARIAN LANGUAGE COURSE (600 LESSONS)

Our One-year Intensive Hungarian Language Course equips Learners with general language skills needed for everyday life, work or study purposes in 600 lessons, 30 lessons per week. In the 30-lesson modules, designed in accordance with the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) levels, all four language competences (listening and reading comprehension, speaking and writing skills) are simultaneously developed.

In addition to the acquisition of language skills, lessons on Hungarian Culture are also included in the course programme.

## 1.2 SIX-MONTH INTENSIVE HUNGARIAN LANGUAGE COURSE

Our Six-month Intensive Hungarian Language Course equips Learners with general language skills needed for everyday life, work or study purposes in 300 lessons, 30 lessons per week. In the 30-lesson modules, designed in line with the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) levels, all four language competences (listening and reading comprehension, speaking and writing skills) are simultaneously developed.

In addition to the acquisition of language skills, lessons on Cultural Studies are also included in the course programme.
